- Deadline: entries must be received by March 31, 2006
- One entry per student, grades 4-12.
- Entries **MUST** include:
  - Student's suggestion for the name of the new boat
  - Student-written paragraph that explains the meaning behind the name suggested
  - Student name, parent name, mailing address, evening phone number, grade, teacher name, school name, and school district
- Entries **MUST NOT** include:
  - Copyrighted or commercially used phrases
  - Slang words or offensive language of any kind
- Judging: by Pittsburgh Voyager staff, board of directors, and community members based on:
  - How well the name reflects the mission of Pittsburgh Voyager
  - How well the name reflects the efforts to build a boat that is friendly to the environment
